Greenwood Village Pool Rules & Guidelines

General Use

- **Pool Hours**: The pool is open daily **from dawn to dusk**.
- Use at Your Own Risk: All residents and guests use the pool at their own risk. By using the facility, individuals agree not to hold Greenwood Village liable for any illness, injury, loss of life, or property damage.
- **No Lifeguard on Duty**: There is no lifeguard on duty. All swimmers are responsible for their own safety.

Behavior and Conduct

- Any person who violates pool rules or engages in unsafe or inappropriate behavior may
 be asked to leave for the remainder of the day. Repeat violations will be addressed on a
 case-by-case basis.
- No running, roughhousing, pushing, dunking, wrestling, diving, or disruptive ball/frisbee play in or around the pool.
- Diving is strictly prohibited.
- Public intoxication will not be tolerated. Individuals displaying signs of intoxication will be asked to leave the pool area.
- Smoking, including the use of electronic smoking devices, is **not allowed** in the pool area.

Supervision & Guests

- Children under 15 **years of age** must be accompanied by a resident who is at least 18 years old.
- Residents aged 18 and older may bring a maximum of two (2) guests per household.
- The pool may be used by party guests, but it **cannot be reserved exclusively**. Pool use must be shared with the community at all times. Party guests must follow all pool rules.

Weather & Emergencies

- All residents and guests must vacate the pool area during **severe weather** (e.g., thunderstorms, lightning).
- Any equipment malfunctions, damage, or concerns should be reported to **Cranberry Community Management** at info@cranberrypm.com

Hygiene & Attire

- Proper swimwear is required. Jeans, cut-offs, sweatpants, or other non-swim materials are not allowed in the pool.
- Children in diapers must wear approved swim diapers (e.g., Little Swimmers or similar).
- Residents and guests with open wounds, sores, or contagious medical conditions **may not** use the pool.

Food, Drink & Cleanliness

- Food and beverages are allowed in the pool area only.
- Glass containers of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- Alcohol is permitted, but glass bottles are not allowed.
- Please dispose of all trash in the provided receptacles. Help keep the area clean for everyone.

Pool Toys & Equipment

- Flotation devices for child safety are permitted.
- Pool toys and other items may be used as long as they do not interfere with others' enjoyment of the pool.

Restroom & Clubhouse Access

- Swimmers must towel dry before entering the clubhouse to use restrooms.
- Use the side entrance only, do not use the front door.
- Bare feet are not permitted inside the clubhouse at any time.
- Please help maintain cleanliness in restrooms.

Closing the Pool Area

- When leaving:
 - o Return all pool furniture to its original location.
 - o Close all umbrellas.
 - Ensure the **pool gate is securely closed**.
- Entry to the pool is allowed only through the designated gate.

Rule for Entry for Pool

• To access the pool, all community members, including children, are required to wear their HOA-issued wristbands at all times.
